What's not covered by my insurer?

Hospital grade pumps

How do I get my pump?

When you call Edgepark they will ask for :

Your name, address, date of birth, and phone number

The information listed on your health insurance card, including policy or identification number, group number, and health insurance plan's phone number

Your diagnosis or underlying condition

Your doctor's name and phone number, or that of the doctor treating your condition, and your primary care physician

A valid e-mail address

Once information is received they will contact your doctor to verify your prescription, and contact your health insurance provider to verify your policy information
